Direct Debits - An Taisce Notes:

- Do not send to your bank – Please complete below and on the left and return to Membership, An Taisce, Tailors' Hall, Back Lane, Dublin, D08 X2A3, Ireland.
- All members with a direct debit will be automatically posted their membership card each January
- If you have an existing standing order and are replacing it with this direct debit, you must write to your bank to cancel the existing Standing Order. An Taisce cannot cancel Standing Orders.
- If you are updating your bank details for an existing Direct Debit, then once this information is updated the previous Direct Debit becomes automatically null and void.
